## **Key responsibilities:**

- Contribute to proposal writing and development of research design
- Develop data collection tools and management systems for the surveys.
- Conducting data collection training and workshops for field enumerators.
- Supervise and maintain quality of field data collection.
- Conduct analysis for quantitative data.
- Developing and maintaining database as per required statistical formats.
- Troubleshooting of survey application and device (tablet and mobile performance).
- Applying statistical tools and techniques such as Stata and R for data analysis for data management and analysis.
- Presenting survey findings to donors/partners and relevant stakeholders.
- Mentor junior researchers in the team
- Be a teaching fellow/mentor in the MPH program

### **Requirements:**

- A master's degree in public health or a related field from a recognized university or medical school is required. Candidates with MBBS degree will be preferred.
- Research experience of at least 1 year is mandatory. Candidates with prior experience of both data collection and data analysis experience will be priortised.
- Must have scientific writing skills and a good command of writing and speaking English as well.
