The aim of this project is to enhance food and nutrition security via an increase in women's empowerment.

To implement this study, BRAC JPGSPH will recruit Field Coordinators to supervise the activities of small data collection teams comprising research assistants. Details are stated below:

Job Responsibilities: The main responsibilities are as follows:

- Facilitate and supervise community-based data collection activities in the pre-selected districts of Bangladesh;
- Visit the study clusters and conduct community sensitization meetings ahead of data collection; •
- Ensure availability and readiness of the logistics for each of the research assistants; •
- Monitor all project activities, including data collection and supply chain management; •
- Assist in the financial management of the project, e.g., documentation of bills and vouchers. •
- Facilitate transfer and settlement of the data collection teams between the study clusters/areas.
- Reinterview of the respondents •
- Organizing meeting at field •
- Developing communication with local stakeholder and community •

- Master's degree from Social Science discipline with good academic records
- Minimum 10 years of experience in supervising research activities
- Experience in using MS Office and Excel •
- Good communication skills both in Bengali and English •
- Willing to stay and work in rural areas. •
