The IT Officer (Infrastructure & Web Systems) supports daily IT operations including networking, server support, asset management, and web development. This position is key in maintaining a secure, efficient, and accessible technology environment for the institution.

Key responsibilities:

- Assist in maintaining servers, backups, network devices, and firewall configurations.
- Provide support for web-based systems and platforms including CMS and ERP portals.
- Support cloud-based services like Google Workspace and Office 365.
- Configure and maintain network infrastructure: switches, routers, access points.
- Track IT asset inventory, conduct tagging, and support IT procurement processes.
- Monitor IT equipment health and report anomalies to the Senior IT Officer.
- Assist in executing IT projects, process audits, and technology upgrades.
- Support web content management and coordinate updates with Communications Department.

Required Skills & Qualifications

- Bachelors in computer science, IT, or a related field.
- 1–3 years of relevant experience in IT support or system/network admin.
- Basic knowledge of WordPress, DNS, cPanel, and SSL configuration.
- Familiarity with networking tools, IP setup, and router configuration.
- Strong problem-solving skills and ability to work in a team environment.
- Understanding of IT asset lifecycle and inventory tools.
