To support this research project, we are looking for Research Assistants (RA) who will be responsible for conducting and transcribing qualitative interviews at study sites in Bangladesh. Details are stated below:

Job Responsibilities

- 1. Conduct qualitative interviews including Key Informant Interviews (KIIs), In-depth Interviews (IDIs), and Focus Group Discussions (FGDs) and observation
- 2. Transcribe qualitative interviews
- 3. Maintain data collection equipment such as recorders
- 4. Submit travel and other bills as per instructions
- 5. Participate in regular team meetings
- 6. Carry out any other duties related to the research project as requested by the supervisor

Requirement

- Bachelor's degree in Anthropology or a related discipline from a recognized university
- Experience in qualitative research
- Proficiency in using digital recorders for field data collection
- Strong communication and writing skills in both English and Bangla
- Willingness to stay and work anywhere in Bangladesh (rural/urban areas)

Salary: 30,000 BDT per month. All actual costs incurred during field visits will be reimbursed.
