This call for recruitment is on behalf of the Humanitarian Hub of BRAC JPGSPH.

Project Brief:

We are conducting a qualitative study titled "Understanding the Impacts of Climate Change on Food Systems, Nutrition and Public Health in Satkhira". This study will be carried out within Satkhira, and we are currently looking for Research Assistants to conduct qualitative data collection. Ideal candidates should have a background in anthropology, sociology, public health, or agricultural sciences, with experience in qualitative data collection, especially in rural or coastal contexts.

Job Responsibilities:

- Conduct qualitative data collection (IDI, PRA, KII, FGD, Photovoice)
- Communicate with community stakeholders prior to the activities and throughout the study.
- Note-taking and transcribing.

Requirement

- A bachelor's degree in **anthropology**, **sociology**, **public health**, **or agricultural sciences** with 1–2 years of hands-on experience in qualitative data collection, particularly in rural or coastal areas.
- Strong written and verbal communication skills in both Bengali and English.
- Willingness and interest in working across different locations in Bangladesh.

Salary: Daily wages basis.

Contract Duration: Contract period will start on September 1st, and will end on November 30th 2025. Within this contract period, you will have 35 working days.
