Job Responsibilities

1. Conduct quantitative interviews including health facility assessment, observation of NCD service delivery, community survey and anthropometric measurement, blood pressure and blood glucose measurement
2. Maintain data collection equipment such as recorders and tablet computers
3. Submit travel and other bills as per instructions
4. Participate in regular team meetings
5. Carry out any other duties related to the research project as requested by the supervisor

Requirement

- Bachelors in any discipline from a reputed university
- Previous experiences in quantitative and qualitative data collection, anthropometry, blood glucose and blood pressure measurement
- Previous experiences in collecting data using tablet computer
- Strong communication and writing skills in both English and Bangla
- Willingness to stay and work anywhere in both rural and urban areas
