Position: Research Associate

The goal of the school is not only to impart knowledge but also to act as a center of excellence in knowledge creation through research and training that connects with practice.

We are looking for a **Research Associate** for the Study on "Status of Health, Education and Employment among Persons with Neurodevelopmental Disabilities in Bangladesh", which is being conducted by the Centre of Excellence for Urban Equity and Health (CUEH), BRAC JPGSPH.

Key responsibilities:

The main responsibilities of the RA are as follows:

- To lead both quantitative and qualitative research projects in collaboration with partners and donors.
- To plan, organize and implement both qualitative and qualitative data collection processes, and provide guidance and direction to the team for effectively conducting high-quality data.
- Reviewing literature and preparing guidelines for research protocol implementation.
- Conducting Key Informant Interviews (KIIs) and Focus Group Discussions (FGDs), In-Depth Interview (IDI).
- Analyzing data using qualitative data analysis software and preparing interpretations of data.
- Analyzing quantitative data using software and preparing interpretation of data.
- Writing scientific reports and manuscripts for journal publications.
- Mentor junior researchers in the team to implement the research and conduct high-quality research.
- Organize and facilitate training, and workshops on both quantitative and qualitative research.
- Some other administrative tasks related to implementing the research.

Educational Qualification:

- A Master's degree in public health or a related field from a recognized university or medical school is required.
- A Bachelor's degree in development study, international development, Disability and Rehabilitation or other relevant field from a recognized university or institution is mandatory for all applicants.
- Preference will be given to candidates with a degree in a disability-related field.

Other requirements:

- Research and/or project management experience at least 2-3 Years.
- Must have scientific writing skills and good command in writing and speaking English as well.

Work Station: Based in Dhaka. Must be flexible to travel to the field sites during data collection.

Salary: As per JPG policy

The agreement is based on a short-term contractual service arrangement, spanning a duration of three months. There is a potential for extension based on the availability of funds and performance.
