Position: Research Associate

This position will require you to assist the Course Coordinator/Co- Coordinator/Senior faculty in preparing and implementing the courses of the MPH program successfully. One of the responsibilities of the position is to support the current MPH students with their coursework and assist them with their research and publication.

Key responsibilities:

The main responsibilities are as follows:

- Work with the Course Coordinator/Co-Coordinator/Senior faculty to design the courses
- Review the courses of the previous years and update course materials and assessment process in consultation with the relevant course coordinators
- Work as a teaching fellow for all the courses of the year
- Debrief internal and external teaching fellows about the course
- Assist the course coordinators to evaluate answer scripts and quizzes
- Support students with selection of research topic, literature review and publications
- Arrange and provide tutorials for the MPH students
- Follow-up with course coordinators about the submission of grades on time
- Assist the MPH program to select organizations for field visits and research work
- Attend weekly MPH meetings and suggest ideas for future growth of the MPH programme

• A Master's degree in public health from a recognized university.
