UNLOCK THE POWER OF PUBLICATION: THREE-DAY SHORT COURSE ON MANUSCRIPT WRITING

Have you completed a research project or technical report that's gathering dust on your desk? If so, It's time to take the next step. This short course on manuscript writing demystifies the process and shows you how to turn completed study reports into publishable articles. Learn the principles of effective manuscript writing, understand how to search for, and submit to relevant journals, and gain practical skills to navigate the path of manuscript writing with confidence.

ABOUT THE COURSE

A three-Day, full-time (9 am to 5 pm) course; the participants need to submit a letter from their respective organization that they will be given leave for these three days. The prospective participants should come with a recently completed Report and a Laptop.

Briefly, the course will cover the following:

- Why write a manuscript? Who are your audience? How to proceed from the completed report you already have (and most probably submitted to, and approved by your supervisor) to writing the manuscript
- Where and how to begin the writing? How to do Literature review and write?
- Deep dive in IMRAD: writing the different sections
- Data visualisation and interpretation for manuscript, referencing; revising the first draft.
- How to search for relevant Journals? What are the steps of submission? How to respond to reviewers' comments? Writing the rebuttal letter (and the Cover Letter while submitting)
- Scientific misconduct and ethical issues; plagiarism; use of ai (artificial intelligence) in developing and editing the final version

On completion of the course, participants are expected to have the following competencies:

- Understand the basic components of a manuscript and the IMRAD structure, including writing the different components
- How to search relevant literature and write a literature review
 Data visualization of quantitative and qualitative data; how to
- cite and refer; understanding authorship criteria

 Develop high level outline; revise the first draft
- Understand the basic concept of scientific misconduct, ethical issues and plagiarism
- Learn basic steps of submitting to a journal and responding to reviewers

The participants should come with a draft report s/he is working on for practicum.

He has been also a peer reviewer for in reputed international health journals. Currently, under the Centre, he is leading research, advocacy and capacity-building activities relevant to improvement of health systems and advancing UHC in Bangladesh



Dr Nahitun Naher is a public health specialist with expertise in designing and conducting public health including social science research. Experienced in public health issues in Bangladesh and low- and middle-income countries. She was elected as the South-East Asia representative and Co-Chair of the Governance Board at the Emerging Voice (EV) for Global Health (EV4GH) network in 2023, and has subsequently been selected as the Chair in 2025.
