

Field Research Assistants (Short term)

The BRAC James P Grant School of Public Health (JPGSPH) at BRAC University was established in 2004 as an educational and research institution focusing on the integral areas of teaching, research, and services. The goal of the school is not only to impart knowledge but also to act as a center of excellence in knowledge creation through research and training that connects with practice.

JPGSPH is looking for **Field Research Assistants** for the **Air and Noise Monitoring Campaign Across Dhaka city**; a research project in collaboration with Imperial College, London and McGill University, Canada, which is being conducted by the Centre of Excellence for Urban Equity and Health of the school.

Key responsibilities:

- Measures ambient air quality parameters and noise level using field monitoring equipment
- Ensure the safety of the monitoring equipment and safekeeping of the air and noise monitoring data
- Constantly oversee the equipment performance and maintenance whenever required at both fixed and rotating sites to keep it in working order
- Gathering site-specific air and noise monitoring, meteorological, land use and suggested socio-demographic data to the line supervisor(s) on a daily basis
- Any other pertinent tasks assigned by the supervisor(s)

Educational Requirements: Bachelor's degree or equivalent, preferably in Geography and Environmental Science/ Environmental Engineering/ Meteorology/ Mechanical or Electrical and Electronic Engineering or any relevant disciplines from any Government approved university.

Experience Requirements: A brief training to operate the equipment will be provided. **However**, candidates with past experience collecting field-level environmental data will be prioritized.

Additional Requirements: The air and noise monitoring campaign will be mostly field-based. The FRAs may need to travel frequently to the field sites if a new situation arises, such as the malfunctioning of equipment at any of the fixed site locations. Therefore, we are expecting candidates who have

- Ability to move frequently throughout the data collection
- Good communicator
